day 1

Arrive into Berlin – Guided tour of Berlin

Begin your 'Eastern European Wonders' Tour Welcome to Berlin - capital of Germany. On arrival, meet our tour manager at Berlin International airport a Please make your arrangement to reach the hotel on your own if you are not able to meet the tour manager at the designated time. Check-in at the hotel. Later proceed for a guided city tour of Berlin where Hitler rose to power. See the remnants of the Berlin Wall, Brandenburg Gate and the Reichstag, German Parliament Building. Visit Alexander Platz where you will see the world clock. Overnight at the hotel in Berlin.

Berlin Guided Tour of Dresden

After breakfast, we check-out and proceed to Dresden(approx 3 hrs drive), which was destroyed during World war II, Upon arrival proceed for lunch followed by guided tour of Dresden see the Opera House and stroll through Theatre Platz. Visit Zwinger Palace with beautiful fountains. Later proceed to Prague (approx 2 hrs drive). Overnight at the hotel in Prague.

Prague - Guided Tour of Prague – Prague Castle

After buffet breakfast, proceed on a guided city tour of Prague. Start your tour with a visit to Prague Castle, A UNESCO World Heritage site, According to the Guinness Book of World Records, Prague Castle is the largest coherent castle complex in the world, with an area of almost 70,000 m². See the astronomical clock on the town hall and the famous Charles Bridge. Later, this evening, proceed for a cruise on the Vltava River with a local guide. Overnight at the hotel in Prague.

Proceed to Salzburg - Guided city tour of Salzburg

After a buffet breakfast, we check out and drive to Salzburg (approx 4 hrs drive) upon arrival to proceed for a guided tour of this elegant baroque city. Salzburg, full of green hills, romantic gardens and breathtaking valleys, is a picturesque city with small alleys and quaint colorful townhomes. See the birthplace of the legendary Mozart, the Mirabell Palace with its landscaped gardens and the Cathedral in the old town. Stroll along the Altstadt, which was recently granted World Heritage Status by UNESCO. Overnight at the hotel in Salzburg.

Proceed to Bled Lake - Boat Ride

After a buffet breakfast, we check out and drive to Lake Bled (approx 3 hrs drive), a lake in the Julian Alps of the Upper Carniolan region of northwestern Slovenia, where it adjoins the town of Bled. On arrival, proceed to Lake Bled with a boat ride on the typical “pletna” boat. Visit the lone Island in the Lake Bled where the St.Mary’s Church beckons visitors with its bell. Proceed to Guide tour of Ljubljana | Zagreb guide tour

After a buffet breakfast, proceed on a guided city tour of this romantic city situated on the banks of the Ljubljanica River. (approx 45-minute drive) Visit the Preseren Square and Triple Bridge, Baroque Town Hall, Cathedral of St. Nicholas, Dragon Bridge, etc. Enjoy light lunch and later continue drive to Zagreb.

Later, join an experienced English speaking a local guide to see the sights of Zagreb. During your guided city tour visit the TrgBanaJela?i?a - Zagreb's central square, the St. Mark's Church - which sports a multi-colored tile roof constructed in 1880, the HrvatskiSabor - Croatian Parliament, the Ban's Palace - now the Presidential Palace, etc. Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb.

See the Heroes Square, Parliament Building, Széchenyi Chain Bridge and other sights and also visit the Buda Castle – a medieval castle and now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Evening Cruise on Danube River. Overnight at the hotel in Budapest.

Budapest to Bratislava Guided tour to Vienna - the Seegrotte in the Vienna woods

After a buffet breakfast, we check-out and proceed to Bratislava - the capital of Slovakia (Approx 2 hrs drive). On arrival, we proceed on a guided city tour of Bratislava, Visit the Bratislava Castle, the Primates Palace and see the Slavín – from where you get great views of the city see St. Michael's Gate, the first

University Istropolitana, St. Martin's Cathedral (where coronations were performed), the Old Town Hall and the Opera House. After light lunch proceeds to Vienna. (Approx 1 hr drive). Upon arrival, visit Seegrotee in the Vienna Woods. Overnight at the hotel in Vienna.

Vienna Guided City Tour - Krakow

After buffet breakfast, we check out and proceed for a guided city tour of Vienna. Start the tour by visiting the Schonbrunn Palace – one of the most visited places in Vienna. Krakow Guided Walking Tour of Krakow Visit to Auschwitz Concentration Camp

After a buffet breakfast, we proceed on a guided city tour of Krakow. See Florian's Gate and Wawel Castle. Visit the main square (Rynek Główny) of Krakow with its centrally located ClothHall (Sukiennice) which has survived to this day. Later, in the afternoon, we visit Auschwitz Concentration Camp - a symbol of the Holocaust and a grim reminder of what cruelty Man is capable of. Jews were sent there from all over Europe to undergo selection and to be systematically murdered in gas chambers. Overnight at the hotel in Krakow.

Krakow Wieliczka Salt Mine

After a buffet breakfast, check out and get ready for a unique experience. Visit the Wieliczka Salt Mine. The route starts at 64 m deep which includes twenty chambers and ends 135 m below the earth's surface, where the world's biggest museum of mining is located with the unique centuries-old equipment among its exhibits. After lunch, proceed to Warsaw (Approx 4 hrs drive). Overnight at the hotel in Warsaw.

Proceed to Warsaw -Guided Tour of Warsaw

After a buffet breakfast, we take you for a guided city tour of Warsaw. We visit the Old Town Square Market - originally constructed in the late 13th century. It was restored after World War II to its beautiful prewar charm, lined with 17th and 18th-century houses, shops, and restaurants. See the Castle Square, King Sigismund's Column, St. John's Cathedral and the Barbican. Overnight at the hotel in Warsaw. (Meals: B, L, D)
